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### ***What does Revolutionary Leadership look and feel like to me?***

*R*evolutionary Leadership for me, is the embodiment of living from both our humanity and our divinity, unapologetically - with confidence, courage, and conviction. Change that you seek requires deep commitment to put your thoughts into aligned-action! In simple terms - Walking your talk, standing strong in your values, beliefs and not swaying, buckling, or bending to the will and power exerted over you by others – especially those that are in organizational authority.

The power for change and revolution starts within. Accessing, tapping into, cultivating, and using this inner resource of true divine power is the source of the change and revolution we seek. Using our true divine power to command miracles in our daily lives, is the most revolutionary act we all can do. When we stop seeing our external reality as something outside of ourselves and see reality as an expression of our inner selves, we can then resource a peace within that surpasses all that we have been taught, conditioned, and programmed to believe is true.

Living as a Revolutionary Leader means giving up the concept of living outside of yourself for the answers and resources. Revolutionary Leadership requires the relinquishing of all attachments to the anything that is outside of you.

### ***Standing strong in the face of adversity.***

I am busy navigating a space that I am witnessing (yet again) the abuse of power. This time through the school system. One that I myself have endured in my own corporate career. It is the most interesting space to find myself

in, esp. since it is playing like a rerun of my own experience. Those that have been placed in authority within the underbelly of a greater control matrix, still believe that exerting their power over another will be accepted. In an open meeting between the school board and parents, I found myself being pulled off my seat by a force greater than my own and through the strength and power of my voice I spoke my truth. Even though I embody a vibration of higher love and divine grace, it is not to the suppression or absence of my own power. That the higher the capacity to shine love, the heart has the same depth of wrath for which is it asked to express. I did not scream and have a tantrum, but I did stand strong in the face of adversity, I did command the wrath and power of of my heart to express my truth in a manner that others will listen. I did not do this from an ego space but from a space of truth, unapologetically.

All through this current experience and that which I endured in my corporate career in 2019, I leaned into the medicine that White Buffalo Calf Woman shares with us. When White Buffalo Calf Woman appears either in my own Akashic Records or through a reading for a client, as she enters the space, it always feels like just the sheer presence of her; the etheric 'floors' tremble and shake. I don't sense this as a state of fear, rather the complete opposite. Her presence alone commands authority – not over another, but from her own embodiment of the power within, the power that she is, unapologetically.

Once there are enough of us embodying the truth of our sovereignty there will be a tipping point, a natural dissolving of the old outdated systems, one where the peace within, the forgiveness and unconditional love of self, gracefully will end the wars we are fighting within ourselves, and when enough of us are living from an embodied space of peace, grace and sovereignty, the world that we know will evolve.

Anger does not end war. More hatred does not end discrimination. Witnessing these world events from a space of detachment and those on the world stage as aspects of oneself is the resource to know that any and all radical change we all yearn for, for ourselves, our family, our children, our community and for all, lies within.

We can all see the abuse of power and authority through what is gaining attention all-over the news, radio stations and social media. The unconsciousness is 'hitting' the consciousness, in a very public way. At first, I was in in a state of anger. Fighting these world leaders, celebrities, and well-known influencers, that are dominating the airways with veracious lies and varying degrees of falsehoods. Witnessing celebrities, I once adored, now turn my stomach inside out. Spiritual mentors that once got me fired up with their messages, have me questioning, the truth thereof. What I did not realize is that these emotions of anger, disgust, and hatred were the very fuel that was re-igniting this fire to become an uncontrolled blaze of fury. I was feeding the unconsciousness with my consciousness, but not in the way that would dissolve it, but in a manner that was re-fueling it.

It was only through my own journey into the depths of self-forgiveness that I can now look at those perpetuating the 'evil' in the world, as aspects of myself that I have disowned, labelled unforgivable, unlovable, and even 'evil'.

Please I am in no way condoning any of these 'evil' acts and I too experience a wrath of emotions when I witness these crimes of genocide, rape, abuse, and war. The space that I am navigating within myself is starting to know that forgiveness, understanding, compassion and unconditional love is the revolution I wish to see in the world. I do

believe that when enough of us can come from this space, then our external reality will reflect this. Anger projected at war will not end the war, it will only fuel it. Hatred at those that we disagree with, will not end division and discrimination, it only feeds a stronger divide.

I have had to experience a tipping point that involved deep forgiveness of self. Once I could tap into this space of true forgiveness to and for myself, I could witness the external world from a space of compassion and understanding. Before this, I was unable to move beyond the anger and hatred I was experiencing towards these wrong doers and the fury within was raging stronger and stronger, day by day, until this moment I chose to forgive myself.

Are there more layers of self-forgiveness, Oh yeah! Are there organizations on the world stage that still enrage me, a double hell yes!! I simply know now that I am not quite ready to unpack or even see that which is within me in this moment and at this time. I know in time; I will have the courage to do so. For now, I am grateful that I am at least here in my journey of remembrance – and that is I am whole and complete beyond the right and wrong. The beautiful and legendary Sufi mystic and poet, Rumi quotes “Out beyond ideas of wrong-doing and right-doing, there is a field. I’ll meet you there.” This is a quote I lean into time and time again. Nothing is right, wrong, good, bad, this or that. It simply is the energy we give it.

### ***My journey of radical self-forgiveness for which I am chosen to create impact through.***

A few years ago, in the depth of my spiritual journey, I was shown through a past life regression that I was a teenage boy, Johan. Johan had suffered some form of disability and was wheelchair bound. There was a sense that Johan may have been crippled by the polio virus. Johan had a sister, Amelia-Rose.

Amelia-Rose in this past lifetime, is my oldest son, Jack in my current life.

Amelia-Rose, whom we will refer to in her endeared name of Aimee, was beautiful – inside and out. I remember being shown Aimee’s beauty and her long, luscious blond hair in my vision. Everyone adored Aimee. She was the ‘apple of everyone’s eye” Aimee was kind, generous and cared a great deal for others. I was shown in this regression that in a moment of deep despair and depression, Johan had chosen to murder his sister. (An aspect of me has chosen murder.)

I did not ‘see’ the murder in this or any other vision of this lifetime, I just knew I/Johan was the hand that caused her death. I was shown that there was a deep desire from Johan to be seen, and the only way he thought he would be able to be seen, was if Aimee was removed from the picture. In his limited thinking, he would then be noticed and ultimately loved.

The reality was that once Aimee was not around, Johan was faced with the truth that he had lost the one person that truly saw and loved him. Aimee saw Johan, and loved him so deeply, sincerely, and unconditionally. Without her, he was left with nothing – nothing but a gaping hole within. One that he had single handedly caused and was responsible for. Johan was lonely, and more alone that ever.

What was unknown to the limitation of the human understanding was that once this act was done, it would shatter not only that lifetime but would continue to impact many other reincarnations of my soul. In my lifetime as Johan, many declarations were made.

Vows to suffer! Promises to never forget! Oaths to welcome any and all forms punishment! Declarations to never be free, seen or loved!

My soul has experienced these promises, vows, oaths, and declarations over and over again in many forms and in many varying degrees of pain. I was shown that my soul has been earnestly seeking retribution.

Johan never considered suicide, to him any release from the pain was not an option. There would not be any ‘easy way out’ for him. He declared that he was going to live a long life of pain, suffering and torture. I was shown the I/Johan, died as a very old and lonely man, with only the skin on his bones. This showed me that any form of love, nurturance or pleasure was denied.

This single act would change the landscape of not only that lifetime but the lifetime I, Taryn am living now, amongst many others, I am sure. Throughout the last decade of my own life, I have searched for many answers through many different healing modalities. During one deep dive, I received the understanding that karma is simply the healing being brought into completion. I took that soul's life in that lifetime and karma is that I gave that soul life in this lifetime. Johan took Aimee's life and Taryn would give Jack life. The healing of the karmic contract is complete.

I was also shown in a family constellation that the soul that Aimee/ Jack share has forgiven Johan/ me. I was the one holding onto unforgiveness. The depth of my own unforgiveness was even too much for my then facilitator to bear. Her words were, that even after 1000's of constellations, she has never felt the depth of pain that I was carrying in my heart. When I received healing in that constellation it was only tapping into the very tip of a really large and deep iceberg.

During a meditation a few years later, I realized that even my weight issues in this lifetime are linked to that lifetime. As soon I get thin (having died with only my skin on my bones in that lifetime), I trigger the trauma of that lifetime and as a need to protect myself from the depth of pain, I instantly add more weight on as an avoidance to accessing that pain.

It was only a few months ago, whilst exploring in my own Akashic Records, that I was again shown the impact that that single act is still having in my life now. I was asked to receive this new opportunity to release myself from the punishment, pain, and suffering that I had promised myself back when I was Johan. I unpacked all the reasons why I was unwilling to do this and equally all the reasons why I was now ready, willing and that I even had the capacity to do so. In the moment I decided to release, let go and surrender - I was able to gift myself the forgiveness I was seeking and the deep desire to be free.

It's like a light switch was switch back on. What I did not foresee was how this new single act of radical self-forgiveness would shape the way I was able to interact with those on the world stage. Where there was only dark and shadow, I can see light. This has shown me the power that when we can love, forgive and bring peace into our own lives, when we courageous embody the revolution we have come here to be – we get to access a depth of radical and unconditional love and peace beginning in our own heart first and foremost, and from this space, we can then witness, and experience the change in the world as we know it.

As I've sat and marinated in this new awareness and beyond that, the embodiment of this, I've started to expand within my own perspective of the world. I see the world as various aspects of myself.

Truth be told, I'm not ready right now to forgive or see the light through certain reflections, and that is okay. Rome, they say was not built in one day. This lifetime is not about the destination, in fact we are being asked to release all the ways that we have set ourselves up to be destination bound, for we are asked to be journey driven. Forgiveness, Peace, and Unconditional love is not a destination we arrive at and stay in; we visit and revisited various aspects of sacred sites within our body, heart, mind and soul, on our journey called life. On this journey, we are asked to radically embody the remembrance of how complete and whole we have always been.

Recently I have been shown that even though this lifetime requires many moments of courage, I have been asked to take a more intimate look at those that have chosen to be the 'bad guy' in their lifetime, as the most heroic act of courage.

When we decided to learn, for example a lesson of self-love or self-forgiveness, we enter into a contract with another soul that is seeking to learn a lesson of unconditional love and forgiveness of another. It is still under debate if we truly realize the human depth that these lessons would lead us into, on this physical world of form. Both sides require a courage to live this heroic human lifetime. For me, the lesson of self-love or self-forgiveness involved the murder of my sister in that lifetime, that would live within me for eternity. I will always have access to the wisdom and reference of that trauma, but it is a personal choice to live here no longer. What I am learning, is that once I release myself from this trauma's cellular memory and all the scar tissue thereof, I get to shape shift my reality before my very eyes.

When we consciously choose to no longer live within the suffering that we've declared to live within for eternity, and when we consciously choose the revolutionary act of radical self-forgiveness and self-love, we get to live in a new energy of peace, love, sovereignty and grace for eternity and our entire reality changes around us to reflect this new state of being.

The evening before I was to submit this chapter, I was watching "TOPGUN Maverick" at the theatres. I deeply related to the character Pete "Maverick" Mitchell. If you recall from the original TOPGUN in 1986, Maverick's wingman, Goose died, and a cross of which Maverick himself carried. I sat in the theatre and sobbed. I was not sobbing for that which I was witnessing on the big screen, I was sobbing as a release for this wound within me that is still very raw. I wept for the life of my sister that I regret taking, and I wept in deep appreciation for the life my son, Jack has gifted me, so that I could begin healing this wound within.

I know that by courageously allowing myself the permission to be so vulnerable in this book, I get to turn a page and create a new chapter in my life, hereon forward.
